In Memorium



Carolyn Virginia Hunt passed away at Peace Arch Hospital on September 28, 2006, after a valiant and hard-fought battle against cancer.

She is survived by her daughter Sunni, her son Kalev, her brothers Tom and Chris, her aunt Pat, and many loving cousins, nieces, nephews, family, and friends.

Born in London, England, Carolyn "commuted" between England and Australia as a teenager and worked for a travelling theatre troupe in England before love and hope led her to Canada, where she settled in Vancouver with her husband Peter in 1968.

Carolyn first graced the stage at Metro Theatre in the early 1970s before taking a sabbatical over a decade long to raise her two children.

She made her triumphant return to acting in 1987, appearing as the lead in *Breath of Spring* for Surrey Little Theatre. Many subsequent productions followed, for companies including Langley Playhouse, Metro Theatre, and White Rock Playhouse. Carolyn's favourite roles included Mr. Mole in *Wind in the Willows*, Marmee in *Little Women*, Aurelia in *Letters Home*, and Esmerelda in *Penumbra*, for which she won the Community Theatre Coalition's award for Best Supporting Actress in 2005.

Carolyn's dynamic voice, commanding presence, and quiet grace will be missed not only by family and friends but also by thespians and audiences throughout the Lower Mainland.

Her talent as an actress was eclipsed only by her bright and loving spirit; while her absence leaves a hole in many lives, her love leaves the world that much more beautiful.
